- Set the tone from the top
 - Value and prioritize the educational mission
- Provide support and incentivize
 - Protected time for educational activity
 - Develop specific, measurable productivity metrics
 - Example: number of publications with trainees
- Enhance visibility
 - Promote participation in subspecialty societies/AAN/ANA committees
 - Encourage leadership roles on specialty foundation boards



Promote Novel Scholarly Contributions


- Development of subspecialty curricula

 - Wellness activities




