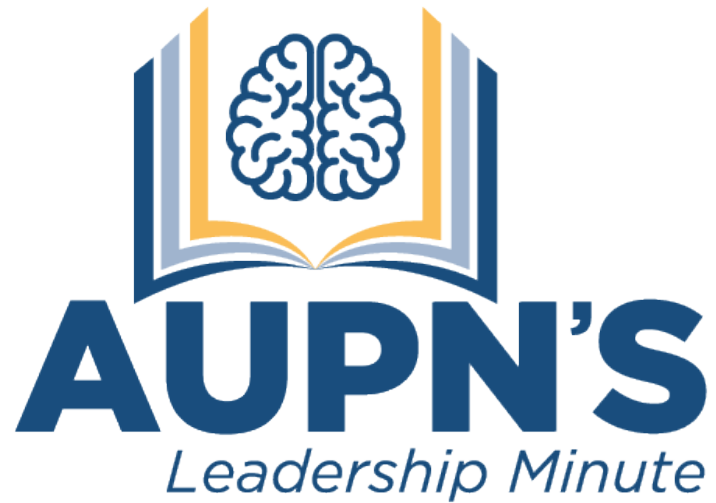
# NEUROLOGY PERSONAL STATEMENTS GREATEST HITS
